Pastor's Thoughts...

My dog and I take a daily walk, and it is the highlight of the day for my canine friend. We usually walk in the late afternoon before dinner and after the kids have arrived home from school. My youngest son likes to tag along, too. Our dog is a retired greyhound. She is long, tall, and skinny, but even though she may look slight of build, she is 82 lbs. She is certainly considered a large dog and can be somewhat intimidating to someone who does not know better. She is a coward.

My dog is actually a huge coward. She is afraid of sticks. I have a dog that is afraid of sticks. Greyhounds are not the kind of dogs that like to play fetch. If you throw something they want they will go get it, but they have no interest of bringing it back to you. They are almost offended you threw it when they were standing right next to you. So, my dog is scared of sticks. She must have tripped on a stick when she was running the backyard at some point and decided that the pain of being poked with a stick was the worst thing that could happen to her. If there is a stick on the sidewalk, she makes extraordinary effort to go around it at all costs. She will not be hurt again and does not care what I think about it.
